#### NEXT WEEKEND marks Laetare Sunday

The fourth Sunday of Lent is named for the Latin word *laetare* meaning *rejoice*. It is taken from the Latin translation of Isaiah 66:10 which reads Rejoice with Jerusalem, and be glad for her; rejoice with her in joy, all you who mourn over her. (NRSV) This Sunday sets a tone of joyful anticipation of the Easter mystery. The Church permits the wearing of rose coloured vestments on this day.

You can join in the joy by wearing the colour pink to Mass on that weekend.
